### Dear SPAAMFAA Member;

The Texas Gulf Coast SPAAMFAA Chapter wishes to welcome you to Houston and Nassau Bay, Texas. The Gulf Coast Chapter will host the 2016 National SPAAMFAA Winter Convention and Muster on February 17<sup>th</sup>, 18th, 19th, and 20<sup>th</sup>, 2016. The Convention will be held at the Clear Lake Hilton and the Muster at Clear Lake Park, a short distance from the Hilton. The Clear Lake Hilton is located at **3000 Nasa Pkwy Houston TX 77058.** 

Field Trips will take place on Thursday the 18<sup>th</sup> and Friday the 19<sup>th</sup>. On Thursday there will be an excursion to the Lone Star Fire Museum Warehouse/Shop and the Historic 1940 Hobby Airport Terminal Museum. Lunch will be provided at the nearby Houston Fire Department's Val Jahnke Fire Training Facility. In the afternoon Houston Fire Department will demonstrate some of their advanced fire equipment and provide a tour of the training facility. A quilt shop hop outing is also available, specially designed to interest wives who may want a special outing.

On Friday February 19th you can travel to Galveston and the Strand for a day of site seeing and shopping. The Strand is home to several maritime museums, the tall ship "Elissa", historical homes, railroad museum, shops, and numerous restaurants. In the afternoon you can take the bus across the island to the Lone Star Flight Museum or if you choose remain on the Strand. For more information visit Galveston.com on the internet. The fee covers bus fare only. The Flight Museum is \$10.00 and meals are on your own. You will also be stopping by for a tour of the Marathon Refinery Fire Station where you will see examples of the latest and greatest in industrial Fire Apparatus. Also available on Friday will be an excursion to the San Jacinto Battlefield, birthplace of Texas Independence from Mexico. This group will also travel to Deer Park for the CIMA (Channel Industries Mutual Aid) Fire Muster where they will some of the largest and most advanced Fire Apparatus in the world. The Battleground is home to the only World War 1 Dreadnaught Battleship in the United States "The Texas" and the 570 foot tall San Jacinto Monument and Museum. (go to: tpwd.texas.gov/state-parks/sanjacinto-battleground). Lunch will be served aboard the Battleship and the bus will be available to tour the Battlefield. The outing will cost \$50.00 including transportation, museum admission, and box lunch.

If these destinations are not of interest to your party, the headquarters Hotel is also conveniently located ½ mile from Space Center Houston, an Education Center and Smithsonian Affiliate Museum. (See Spacecenter.org). Space Center Houston is located on the grounds of the Lyndon B. Johnson Space Center, home and Mission Control Center for the U.S. human space flight program. Transportation to and from the Space Center can be obtained through the Hotel Shuttle or Taxi Service. The Hotel

is also a short distance from the Kemah Boardwalk on Galveston Bay. The Boardwalk is home to restaurants, shops, and an amusement park. Located on the outlet from Clear Lake, it's a great place to watch the shrimp fleet and sailboats leave and return to their docks.

The Clear Lake Hilton, our Headquarters hotel, is located 18.1 miles from Hobby International Airport on the South Side of Houston. Room rates are \$109.00 per night for single or double beds, including multiple occupancy. You can reserve your room by calling 281-333-9300 or 1-800-HILTONS (445-8667). Be sure to mention you are with SPAAMFAA when making reservations to insure your special discounted rate. The cutoff date for these rates is January 15, 2016.
